The PACS Director also noted that it is 'awkward and absurd' when employees of the DILG themselves are alien to the PPAs of the Department.

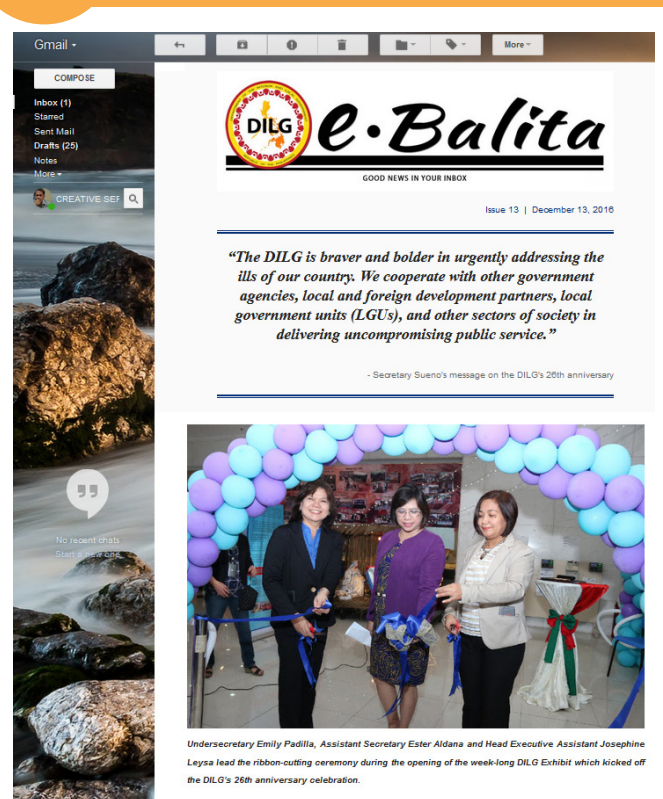
"Being informed is part of our core value on organizational competence and effectiveness; and our brand personality traits of being matino, mahusay, at maaasahan," he said.
