INVITATION TO BID SAFE PHILIPPINES PROJECT (PHASE 1)

1. The Government of the Philippines (GoP) through the Department of Finance (DOF) intends to apply for a Loan from People's Republic of China (PRC) thru the Preferential Buyers Credit Loan of Export-Import Bank of China towards the cost of Safe Philippines Project (Phase I), and it intends to apply part of this loan to eligible payments under the Contract for Safe Philippines Project (Phase I) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Twenty Billion, Three Hundred Thirteen Million, and Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (PHP 20, 313, 920, 000.00)**.
2. The Department of Finance (DOF) as the Borrower through its Procuring Entity, the **Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)** now invites sealed Bids from pre-selected eligible Bidders for Safe Philippines Project (Phase I). Completion of the Works is required within Two (2) Years. Bidders should have completed, within Two (2) Years, a contract similar to the Project.
3. The project entails the construction of (a.) an Integrated Operations and Command Center for the National 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), DILG, Philippine National Police (PNP), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), and Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP); (b.) eighteen (18) city-level Command Centers in Metro Manila and Davao; (c.) video surveillance system linked via a dedicated communications infrastructure; (d.) a data center with remote backup data center with gadgets and equipment; and (e.) such other key deliverables as contained in the Terms of Reference.
4. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the applicable procedures as specified in the Government Procurement Reform Act and is open to the three pre-selected bidders as recommended by the Government of the People's Republic of China, as defined in the Bilateral Agreement. The pre-selected bidders shall be evaluated on the bases of eligibility, technical and financial capabilities. The contract shall be awarded to the Lowest Calculated Responsive Bidder (LCRB) who was determined as such during post-qualification.
5. Pre-selected bidders may obtain further information from the Procuring Entity, the DILG, and inspect the Bidding Documents consisting of (a.) this Invitation to Bid, (b.) Instruction to Bidders in the Required Qualification and Eligibility Documents, (c.) Terms of Reference for the Project, at this address:

A complete set of the Bidding Documents may be purchased and inspected by pre-selected Bidders on the submission of a written application to the address above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Seventy Five Thousand Pesos (PHP 75,000.00)**. For Bidders who will submit their bid proposal, copies of proof for such payment shall be attached to the bids in the Technical Bid envelope only, otherwise the bids shall be rejected. The Bid Documents shall be available from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM from **OCTOBER 10, 2018 until OCTOBER 17, 2018 only**.
7. The DILG-SBAC will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **OCTOBER 17, 2018 at 10:00 AM** at the **DILG-SBAC Office** which shall be open to pre-selected bidders. DILG may release Bid Bulletin on updates, clarifications, amendments or additional Bidding Documents on **OCTOBER 19, 2018**, if any.
8. The eligible Nationality of the Contractor(s) shall be the following: (a.) Chinese in the case of the prime contractor; and (b.) Filipinos in the case of the sub-contractor(s).
9. Bids must be delivered to the Office of the DILG-SBAC on or before **OCTOBER 30, 2018 at 1:00 PM** and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS).
10. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend on **OCTOBER 30, 2018 at 2:00 PM** at the **OSEC Boardroom, 27th Floor DILG – NAPOLCOM Center, EDSA cor. Quezon Avenue, Quezon City, Philippines**.
11. DILG-SBAC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
