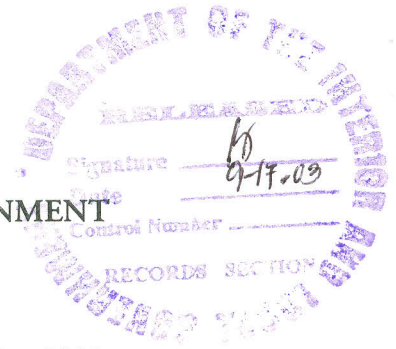

**SUBJECT :** 7<sup>TH</sup> YEAR CELEBRATION OF THE NATIONAL URBAN PEST  
CONTROL WEEK

The National Committee on Urban Pest Control is spearheading the conduct of a Grand Conference relative to the 7<sup>th</sup> Year Celebration of the National Urban Pest Control Week. This conference will be held on September 26, 2003 at the Rembrandt Hotel, Quezon City, with the theme "Pinoy: Magaling, Malikhain at Mapamaraan Tungo Sa Ikakaunlad Ng Bayan".

The objectives of the conference are: 1) to raise the level of ecological awareness and consciousness of the Filipino people; 2) to adopt and practice recycling, reusing and re-commissioning of resources to attain a garbage and pest-free community; and 3) to assist government agencies and their instrumentalities in the promotion of community hygiene to prevent the occurrence of epidemics.

In this connection, Local Chief Executives are encouraged to attend, or to send their representatives to, the said conference on official time. The payment of conference fee, if any, and applicable traveling expenses, per participant, may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, to the usual accounting and auditing requirements, and to all other pertinent laws, rules and regulations.
