**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
NO. 2004-124

**TO :** ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY MAYORS,  
MUNICIPAL MAYORS, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS  
AND OTHERS CONCERNED

**SUBJECT :** AMENDMENT TO DILG MC NO. 99-06 DTD JANUARY 7,  
1999, ENTITLED, ULAP ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES

Executive Order No. 351, s. 2004, entitled, **Recognizing The Union of Local Authorities Of The Philippines (ULAP) As The Umbrella Organization Of All The Leagues Of Local Government Units (LGUs) And Leagues And Federations Of Local Elective And Appointive Officials**, particularly Section 3, thereof provides, quote:

*ULAP shall derive funds from annual assessment fees, special contributions or donations of provinces and cities, and from annual dues from its member-leagues or federations, at the rate to be determined by ULAP and duly-recognized by the Department of the Interior and Local Government through a corresponding Memorandum Circular for that purpose, provided that no funding requirement of ULAP shall be charged to the National Government. It may, in support of its programs and projects, secure financial assistance or undertake fund-raising activities, subject to the pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code and the Omnibus Election Code. (underscoring supplied)*

Relative to the above, and consistent with ULAP Resolution No. 2003-10, s. 2003, titled, **Resolution Establishing An Augmentation Fund For ULAP By Collecting Annual Dues From Its Regular Member-Leagues (Amending ULAP Resolution No. 1998-04)**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 99-06, s. 1999, entitled, **ULAP Annual Membership Dues**, particularly paragraph 2 thereof, is hereby amended to read, as follows:

*Sa Diyos, Sa Tao... Serbisyon Totoo*

*The DILG is the primary catalyst for excellence in local governance that nurtures self-reliant, progressive, orderly, safe and globally-competitive communities sustained by GOD-centered and empowered citizenry*

As part of overall efforts to generate funds to finance the programs, projects and activities of the said Union, the National Executive Board approved, during their 26<sup>th</sup> National Executive Board Meeting held on May 28, 2003 at the Century Park Hotel, Manila, the following *annual membership dues* of Provinces, Cities and Associate Members, beginning Calendar Year 2003:

- Provinces - P30,000 per province;
- Cities - P20,000 per city; and
- Associate Members - P10,000 per member.

In addition, an annual dues of P50,000.00 shall be collected from each of the ULAP regular member-leagues beginning CY 2003, and shall accrue as part of the ULAP's Augmentation Fund.
