



Manila Bay Clean-Up

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 16

EXPEDITING THE REHABILITATION AND RESTORATION OF THE COASTAL AND MARINE ECOSYSTEM OF THE MANILA BAY AND CREATING THE MANILA BAY TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, Section 16. Article II of the Constitution enshrines the policy of the State to protect and advance the right of the people to a belanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

WHEREAS, Section 2(c) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9275 or the "Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004," recognizes that water quality management issues cannot be separated from concerns about water sources and ecological protection, water supply, public health and quality of life:

WHEREAS, Section 2(a) of RA No. 9003 or the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000," mandates the State to adopt a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program which shall ensure the protection of public health and the environment.

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in Metro Manillo Development Authority, et al. v. Concerned Residents of Manillo Bay, etc., at al. (G.R. Nos. 171947-48, 18 December 2008 and 16 February 2011) Issued a Wilt of Confirming Mandamus that directed concerned government agencies and private entities to clean up, rehabilitable, preserve, restore and maintain the waters of the Manillo Bay to a level that is fit for swimming, skin-diving and other forms of contact recreation, as well as to fully implement the Operational Plan for the Manillo Bay Coastal Strategy (OPMECS) pursuant to Section 18(c) of RA No. 9275.


WHEREAS, the Manila Bay Region encompasses the bay surface area of 1,870 km² and coastline of 190 killometers, and a total drainage area of about 17,540 km², which spans across Regions III, IV-A and the National Capital Region (NCR), or a total of 178 local government units (LGUs) and 17 major over systems:

WHEREAS, RA No. 7160 or the "Local Government Code of 1991," calls on all LGUs to ensure the general welfare of its constituents, and to share with the national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance within their respective territorial jurisdictions;


WHEREAS, the convergence of national government agencies and LGUs in the Mantle Bay Region, and the active participation of private and public stakeholders, are necessary to facilitate the robust and integrated implementation of all rehabilitation and restocation efforts at the Manila Bay; and
